Under section 20(2) of the Public Records Act 2005, the Chief Archivist gives notice of her intention to dispose of the public records described in the draft Appraisal Report in accordance with the recommendations outlined in the draft General Disposal Authority (GDA).

Comments received within this period will be considered by the Chief Archivist before finally authorising the GDA.
